Chrism Mass

On **Monday, April 17**, at 7:30 pm, in the Cathedral of St. Francis of Assisi in Metuchen, NJ, Bishop James Checchi will celebrate the Chrism Mass with the priests of the diocese. At this Mass, the bishop will bless the Holy Oils which each parish receives for the rites of anointing. These Holy Oils, which are used to sanctify the Faithful, have been channels of holiness for centuries! The **Oils of Catechumens** is used to anoint the chest of infants and hands of adults before their baptism; the **Oil of the Sick** is used on the forehead and hands of the infirm in the Anointing of the Sick; the **Sacred Chrism** is used to anoint the head of the newly baptized, the foreheads of confirmandi, the hands of a priest at his ordination, and the altar and walls of new churches. At the Mass, all priests make a **Renewal of Commitment to Priestly Service**, recommitting themselves to their Bishop and to their ministry to God and to His people. All are strongly encouraged to join in this ancient, grace-filled Mass. **If you need a ride, be at the CC by 6 pm. Questions? Contact Sr. Lorraine.**
